The Board of Directors (“Board”) of Ecochallenge.org is a governing board and is responsible for oversight of the strategic, financial, operational, and policy decisions for the organization. The Board delegates the administration of policy and practice to the Executive Director and reviews operations on a periodic basis. Membership of the Board should represent leaders who demonstrate significant commitment and passion for the organization’s mission (including its justice mission), strategic planning, and organizational success. Reporting to the Board Chair, Board Members typically serve three-year terms and make a meaningful financial commitment to the organization on an annual basis.

The Board expects the following from its members regarding personal conviction, character and credibility:

- Commitment to the Ecochallenge.org mission
- Commitment to the organization’s values including Environmental Justice and Social Equity
- Advocates for Ecochallenge.org throughout the virtual community
- Demonstrates a breadth of understanding and a tolerance of a variety of viewpoints
- Willingness to state one’s convictions and also accept the majority decision of the Board
- Respected and highly regarded by colleagues and in the community
- Deals respectfully and directly with management, staff, and other Board members
