## Harnessing Our Collective Power to Drive Change

Cleveland Clinic, Mayo Clinic, and PeaceHealth have collaborated with Ecochallenge.org to create an exciting engagement initiative for healthcare employees—the One Healthcare Ecochallenge. From April 1<sup>st</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>, we are inviting healthcare organizations to come together as one to make a positive impact on caregiver, community, and environmental health.

### What is the One Healthcare Ecochallenge?

During this month-long engagement campaign, participants will use the Ecochallenge platform to select actions to take with the goal of forming healthy and sustainable habits. Participants can choose from a suite of daily and one-time actions that promote well-being, resource stewardship, education, collaboration, and more. These actions are grouped into five categories: At Work, At Home, In Our Communities, Health & Well-Being, and One Healthcare.
